The Power of Something from Nothing

Many Somethings From Other Somethings

We have come to the point at which the thing that exists in our sparse view of reality must do something. So, let us consider the principal that is the mandate for actions and entities that have reached this particular point: association. To narrow the field, somewhat; let us look at an association between something that exists at a certain time, and a nothing that has the potential to exist. Well, actually, the nothing that has the potential to exist is actually something that exists; since, in this place in reality, potential is itself a thing that exists. In fact, the whole of this reality, at this point, is potential, restrained.

At this point on the timeline of the existence of the kingdom of man, the potential, restrained, allows us to say that everything that is in this reality can be defined by referring to it as being, the something from which something comes. For instance, among the, much something, that we readily recognize is the earth. On this earth thing, there is a special something that we want to explore more. Scripture describes a unique something that is a part of the design of the earth as being this broad and multi-faceted principle: human occupation.

For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is none else. I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: I said not unto the seed of Jacob, Seek ye me in vain: I the LORD speak righteousness, I declare things that are right.

(Isaiah 45:18-19)

To many people, this may seem to be a trivial matter; however, many scientists--among which are the ecologists--are working vigorously and constantly to remind us of that particular design feature of the earth. There is much study about the quality of the new things that **can** be provided from the things that are here now. We are rapidly learning that the earth itself is subject to this often quoted principle of quality control; "Garbage in; garbage out". Though, we must add that; in our past, from time to time, God has overridden this principle, as we see here.

On the morrow, as they went on their journey, and drew nigh unto the city, Peter went up upon the housetop to pray about the sixth hour: And he became very hungry, and would have eaten: but while they made ready, he fell into a trance, And saw heaven opened, and a certain vessel descending unto him, as it had been a great sheet knit at the four corners, and let down to the earth: Wherein were all manner of fourfooted beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air.

And there came a voice to him, Rise, Peter; kill, and eat.

But Peter said, Not so, Lord; for I have never eaten any thing that is common or unclean.

And the voice spake unto him again the second time, What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common.

This was done thrice: and the vessel was received up again into heaven.

(Acts 10:9-16)

Yes, I know that we could go back a little further in our discovery of the mandate that there be things that come from other things, along with its associated call for care about quality controls. For instance, we could show the mandate is the core principle of all manufacturing: that, service must be a part of our world, in the fashion as it was designed into the original servants of reality, the angels. In Scripture, their product of service is described, thusly.

But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool? Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

(Hebrews 1:13-14)

Their numbers are vast; when one considers that everything that exists can be called into service as an angel of God. For instance, here is a time when pestilence served as an angel of the LORD.

And David's heart smote him after that he had numbered the people. And David said unto the LORD, I have sinned greatly in that I have done: and now, I beseech thee, O LORD, take away the iniquity of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly.

For when David was up in the morning, the word of the LORD came unto the prophet Gad, David's seer, saying, Go and say unto David, Thus saith the LORD, I offer thee three things; choose thee one of them, that I may do it unto thee.

So Gad came to David, and told him, and said unto him, Shall seven years of famine come unto thee in thy land? or wilt thou flee three months before thine enemies, while they pursue thee? or that there be three days' pestilence in thy land? now advise, and see what answer I shall return to him that sent me.

(2 Samuel 24:10-13)

Here is a time, when antibiotics, or some other antigen, served as an angel among the LORD'S representative, in its activity for purposes of delivering healing. Or, maybe this was a time when a devil of illness was brought to its knee, in submission to a higher power of service in the LORD.

And he arose out of the synagogue, and entered into Simon's house. And Simon's wife's mother was taken with a great fever; and they be sought him for her. And he stood over her, and rebuked the fever; and it left her: and immediately she arose and ministered unto them.

(Luke 4:38-39)

You might have noticed that we do not limit the list of potential parents of other things as being just those things that have a biological capability to give birth, or even geological possibilities to give birth. Also, please note that we cannot limit this category to those things that have an immediate utility. For instance, there were certain servants of God that were suspended for an unspecified amount of time, before they were allowed to produce the something that was the ordained products of their design.

And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God, Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.

Also, as we noted about the microbes, the things that come from other things are not necessarily large. Before we go there, though; we must mention a category of things that come from a thing (or things) that are not even of the same sort as they are. These things did their work in a fashion that would be like having a building emerge from floating chemicals--such things as, mortar dust, plaster particles, plant residue, etc. Of course, this sort of thing has not, yet, been physically seen, but it still has a precedent for its possibility. The precedent for its possibility is this one.

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good report. Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

(Hebrews 11:1-3)

• And, here is the source:

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath showed it unto them.

For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

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Okay; now, we will return to this side of reality's separation of itself; the natural side. On the natural side, we are very much dependent on the integrity of the process of, something from something else. Our most basic dependence was set in place before there was an, us.

Please forgive me; I cannot leave the supernatural side, just yet; for, the first thing on which we depend was set up on the supernatural side, and then, it laid itself on the natural side. There are some scientists that refer to this supernatural-natural spanning things as, the Big Bang. Yes, the Big Bang would have to be a supernatural thing because it would have to come about by itself (or, as we religious folks like to think; it would have to have flowed from God's Creativity.)

There is no need for a long discussion on this matter; if the Big Bang is truly the start of our natural reality, then, by definition, it must be supernatural because it is external to the natural. It may even be a portion of the immense reality that is described in these <u>religious</u> words.

And now, Israel, what doth the LORD thy God require of thee, but to fear the LORD thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the LORD thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul, To keep the commandments of the LORD, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good?

Behold, the heaven and the heaven of heavens is the LORD'S thy God, the earth also, with all that therein is.

(Deuteronomy 10:12-14)

This is that same portion of the immense reality, as it was described in these <u>philosophical</u> words, of which the Big Bang was (if it did, in fact, happen) a part..

And now, O God of Israel, let thy word, I pray thee, be verified, which thou spakest unto thy servant David my father. But will God indeed dwell on the earth? behold, the heaven and heaven of heavens cannot contain thee; how much less this house that I have builded?

Yet have thou respect unto the prayer of thy servant, and to his supplication, O LORD my God, to hearken unto the cry and to the prayer, which thy servant prayeth before thee to day: That thine eyes may be open toward this house night and day, even toward the place of which thou hast said, My name shall be there: that thou mayest hearken unto the prayer which thy servant shall make toward this place.

(1 Kings 8:26	-29)
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So, when the supernatural event had laid the foundation of the natural, we received a thing known as subatomic particles. No, I will not discuss the various levels of subatomic particles; I only need to tap into their ability to produce something from their own self. One of the things that were produced from the subatomic particles is the molecule, oxygen. Yes, this does mean that God is a very busy SOMETHING, from which many things come; but, we do not want to start an argument about this operation of the First Something from Nothing--also known as, The First Cause. Instead, we want to look at a part of the process, and proceed, from there, to go to a generalization. Okay, enough of that. Let us, once again, return to the natural. In the design of water, it is defined by a specialized combination of hydrogen and oxygen.
